## INDIAN DAIRY INDUSTRY: NEW BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES

Major growth drivers for the Indian dairy Industry are rapid urbanization, conducive Government policies, fast increasing disposable income, stringent quality guidelines laid down by the government and increasing consumer base.

### Key Numbers

- India is targeting to achieve liquid milk production capacity of 300 MMT by 2024-25
- Indian Dairy industry is expected to touch USD 380 billion by 2028 from 182 billion in 2022, with CAGR of 13.2% during 2023-2028
- Per Capita milk consumption increased from 307 grm/Day in 2013-2014 to 444 grm/Day in 2021-22
- Indian Cheese market is expected to reach USD 1.5 billion, growing at CAGR of 18.5% between 2021-26
- Yogurt market is expected to touch USD 6 billion, growing at CAGR of 15% between 2021-26
- Ice Cream market which was valued of 2.4 billion in 2022 is expected to grow at CAGR of 17.5% between 2023-28
- Flavoured milk market which is currently valued of USD 0.40 billion is expected to grow at CAGR of 22% between 2023-28

Today, India is the largest producer of milk in the world, achieving an annual production of 221.06 million tonnes during the year 2021-22 & contributing 23% of global milk production.

The cooperative societies have not only made the farmers self-sufficient but have also broken the shackles of gender, caste, religion, and community.
